Redfish (slot) White Trout Croaker Flounder Speckled Trout (slot) Sheepshead

- Entry fees : \$30 /angler before May 11th and \$40 /angler after May 11th
- Registration is via online only @ www.inshoreclassic.org. No entry fees will be accepted after 5:00 pm on Friday May 17th. Tournament merchandise (T-shirts, etc) is sold separately on a first come first served basis. Extra merchandise will be sold at the weigh-in.
- No fishing allowed until 5:00 am on the day of the tournament.
- If a small craft ADVISORY is in effect at 5:00 am on 05/18/24, the tournament is cancelled. All category prizes will be drawn as door prizes and winners will be notified.
- All fish must be caught on hook and line and meet Alabama size regulations. Redfish slot limit is 16"-26", and speckled trout slot is 15"-22" measured with pinched tail on tournament's weigh stick. ALL DECISIONS BY WEIGHMASTER ARE FINAL.
- Weigh in is at Holy Spirit Hall (Formerly Camp Cullen) in Point Clear and begins at 2:00 pm and ends at 5:00 pm sharp. Anglers must be in line at 5:00 pm in order to weigh fish. Official time is held by the Weighmaster. A drawing for door prizes will be held and participants do not need to be present to win. Youth door prizes will be drawn separately.
- NO WEIGH IN BY BOAT. PARKING IS LIMITED SO PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY
- Only one fish per category per person is allowed to win a category prize. The person who weighed their fish first will determine tiebreakers. Youth ages 14 and under will compete in the youth division only.
- Prize money and the number of places per category will be awarded based on tournament participation. Unfilled places in categories become door prizes.
- Food will be served from 1:00 -5:00.
- All decisions by the Rules Committee are final. Any matter not specifically covered by these rules may be decided by and at the sole discretion of the rules committee.
